

## Developing a Portfolio

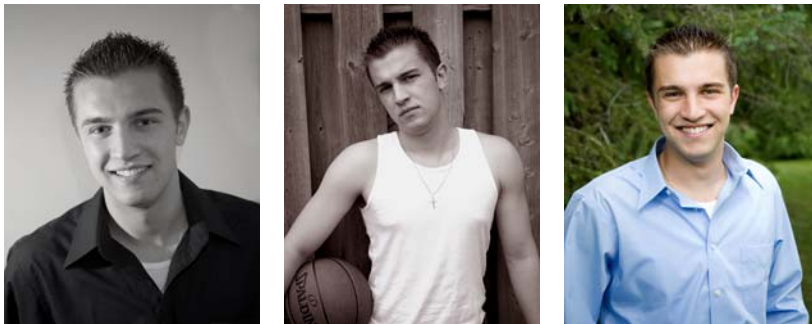
